WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe of Nebraska is federally recognized Indian tribe of organized under a constitution and bylaws approved by the Secretary of Interior on April 30, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Article III, Sec.1 of the constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska, the governing body of the Omaha Tribe shall also be known as Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS: Article IV, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska provides the Omaha Tribal Council with the power to safeguard and promote the economy and general welfare of the Omaha Tribe; and,

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe has been awarded a 5311 FTA transit grant through application made with FTA Region 7, and the Omaha Tribe has established the Omaha Tribe Public Transit, a demand response service for the public on the Omaha Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe Public Transit request the Chairman as a designee authorized by resolution #: 24-74 to take the following actions regarding FTA or (State) DOT funded transit projects
