## OMAHA TRIBE OF NEBRASKA

RE: Approving the Pe'Zhitu Village Infrastructure Subrecipient Agreement between the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska and the Omaha Tribal Housing Authority

- WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian tribe, organized under a constitution and bylaws approved by the Secretary of Interior on April 30, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934; and
- WHEREAS: pursuant to Article III, Sec.1 of the constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska, the governing body of the Omaha Tribe shall also be known as Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS: Article IV, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska provides the Omaha Tribal Council with the power to safeguard and promote the economy and general welfare of the Omaha Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska was allocated Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) from the U.S. Department of the Treasury established under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- WHEREAS, the ARPA states that a Tribal government may use SLFRF payments, among other things, "to cover costs incurred by the Tribal government, by December 31, 2024 ... to respond to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") or its negative economic impacts," including infrastructure provided by Tribal Governments to establish low-income housing programs; and
- WHEREAS, The Omaha Tribal Housing Authority is seeking to establish a sub-recipient agreement with the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska for the amount of \$1,500,000; and
- **WHEREAS,** Under the Subrecipient Agreement (*Attachment A*), low-income housing infrastructure projects have been established and budgets outlined for each objective; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:** considering the mutual terms and conditions outlined in the Subrecipient Agreement (*Attachment A*), the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska desires to offer a sub-award to the Omaha Tribal Housing Authority to ensure the successful completion of the Pe'Zhitu Village Infrastructure project.
