RESOLUTION NO. 24-<u>159</u> OF THE OMAHA TRIBE OF NEBRASKA

RE: Application For and Acceptance of One Time Funding from BIA for Natural Resources Conservation, In The Amount of \$100,000.

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian tribe, organized under a constitution and bylaws approved by the Secretary of Interior on April 30, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Article III, Sec.1 of the constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska, the governing body of the Omaha Tribe shall also be known as Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS: Article IV, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska provides the Omaha Tribal Council with the power to safeguard and promote the economy and general welfare of the Omaha Tribe; and

WHEREAS: Omaha Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, (I)j, has the Responsibility to safeguard, promote and enforce the peace, economy, safety, law and order, and general welfare of the Tribe and the Omaha Reservation; and

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe operates a number of programs in facilities located throughout the Tribe's service area; and

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe desires that public health and safety standards be met for each of the Tribe's facilities; and

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe finds that its Wildlife and Parks program needs an additional conservation officer, pursuant to Tribal Code 15 of the Omaha Tribal Codes for Wildlife and Parks

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Omaha Tribal Council of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska authorizes the application for the one-time funding for Natural Resources Conservation from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, in the amount of \$100,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: Upon submittal, acceptance and awarding of the proposed grant by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, that the Omaha Tribal Council accepts the Natural Resources Conservation grant, for its approved purposes.
