RE: Appointing Shani Parker as the Authorized Organizational Representative for the Tribe's National Telecommunications and Information Administration's Middle Mile Grant Project.

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian tribe, organized under a constitution and bylaws approved by the Secretary of Interior on April 30, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Article III, Sec.1 of the constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska, the governing body of the Omaha Tribe shall also be known as Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS: Article IV, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska provides the Omaha Tribal Council with the power to safeguard and promote the economy and general welfare of the Omaha Tribe; and

WHEREAS: Article IV, Section 1 (m) To adopt resolutions regulating the procedures of the Tribal Council itself and of other Tribal agencies and Tribal offices; and

WHEREAS: In 2022 the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska applied for and was awarded funding for the National Telecommunication and Information Administration (NTIA) Middle Mile Grant Project; and

WHEREAS: The current assigned Authorized Organizational Representative (AOR) is no longer employed by the Tribe is unavailable to act in that capacity for the Tribe; and

WHEREAS: An AOR is needed to submit applications, submit reports and other important documents, and receive and send important communications with the grantor; and

WHEREAS: Timely reports and other documents are imperative to grant compliance and fulfillment of grant requirements; and

WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe of Nebraska is unable to complete necessary grant reports without an active AOR.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Omaha Tribal Council finds it is in the best interest of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska to Appoint Shani Parker as the AOR of the Tribe's NTIA Middle Mile Grant award.
