RESOLUTION NO. 25-65

OF THE

OMAHA TRIBE OF NEBRASKA

RE: Title 27 TERO, Section 27-3-3 Composition of Commissioners Amendment

- WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian tribe, organized under a constitution and bylaws approved by the Secretary of Interior on April 30, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934; and
- **WHEREAS:** pursuant to Article III, Sec.1 of the constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska, the governing body of the Omaha Tribe shall also be known as Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS: Article IV, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska provides the Omaha Tribal Council with the power to safeguard and promote the economy and general welfare of the Omaha Tribe; and
- WHEREAS: Article IV, Section 1 (m) To adopt resolutions regulating the procedures of the Tribal Council itself and of other Tribal agencies and Tribal offices; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribe has adopted a Tribal Code to ensure the orderly and efficient governance of its affairs, which includes Title 27 governing the Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO); and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council recognizes the need to amend the provisions of Title 27 to enhance the composition and decision-making processes of the TERO Commission to better serve the community; and
- WHEREAS, the Council desires to amend <u>Title 27</u>, <u>Section 27-3-3 Composition of the Commission</u> to revise the structure and terms of appointment for Commission members and to clarify quorum and voting requirements for Commission decisions; and
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Omaha Tribal Council, acting pursuant to its constitutional authority, that Title 27 of the Tribal Code is hereby amended as follows:
- Section 27-3-3 Composition of the Commission.
 - (a) "The Commission shall be composed of **five (5) members** in good standing in the community. Three (3) members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Council in January of odd

- numbered years, and each for a term of two (2) years; and two (2) members shall be appointed in even numbered years, each initially for a term of one (1) year, thereafter being appointed in January of even-numbered years each for a term of two (2) years...."
- (b) Decisions of the TERO Commission shall be made by majority vote. A quorum shall consist of any three (3) Commission members.
- **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:** The Omaha Tribal Council finds it is in the best interest of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska to amend Title 27, Section 27-3-3 Composition of Commission, from three (3) Commission members to five (5) Commission members.
