RESOLUTION NO. 25-69 OF THE

OMAHA TRIBE OF NEBRASKA

RE:

Storm Purchase Irrigation Equipment

- **WHEREAS:** The Omaha Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian tribe, organized under a constitution and bylaws approved by the Secretary of Interior on April 30, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934; and
- **WHEREAS:** pursuant to Article III, Sec.1 of the constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska, the governing body of the Omaha Tribe shall also be known as the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS: Article IV, Section 1 (j) of the Constitution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska provides the Omaha Tribal Council with the power to safeguard and promote the economy and general welfare of the Omaha Tribe; and
- **WHEREAS:** The Omaha Tribal Council determines that it is in the best interest of the Omaha Tribe to purchase certain areas of private land for use by the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS: The Omaha Tribe Realty Department, as designee of the Omaha Tribal Council, has expressed interest in purchasing for, but not limited to, agricultural use The proposed property (Pivots and pumps) are described as follows:
 6 tower Valley 8000 pivot, 1825 total hours, 40 hp submersible pump.
 10 tower Valley 8000 pivot, VRI 4460 total hours, 60 hp submersible pump.
 15 tower Valley 8000 pivot, VRI 3452 total hours, 100 hp submersible pump.
 8 tower Valley 8000 pivot, 2496 total hours, 40 hp submersible pump.
 9 tower Valley 8000 pivot, 90 total hours, 50 hp submersible pump.
 10 tower Valley 8000 pivot, approximately 1800 hours, gear head pump.
 8 tower Valley 8000 pivot, VRI, 3567 total hours, 40 hp submersible pump.
 16 tower Valley 8000 pivot, VRI, 1804 total hours, 100 hp submersible pump.
- WHEREAS, The Omaha Tribe has negotiated a price of up to \$700,000.00 and, by this resolution, intends to agree to pursue financing for the purchase of this equipment owned by Michael Storm.
- **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Omaha Tribal Council approves the purchase of the irrigation property from Michael Storm and to pursue financing for the amount of up

to \$700,000.00 for fund such purchase by the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska. The Omaha Tribal Council authorizes the [CTO, the acting CFO, the Realty Director and the Farm Manager] to negotiate all matters and documentation and bring to the Council for final approval.
